Vestry 2018 - April 22nd

Regarding the break in at the church. Churches do not necessarily report it if churches are broken into. It does not seem as though anything was taken. To replace the window it was around \$300 to fix. We will not submit it to insurance, as the cost was so low.

However, the Vestry would like to get a motion detector light that will go on when someone enter the perimeter. Purchasing an alarm system is very, very expensive. We already have video surveillance but we don't have stickers that help people know. We will ask Cindi to increase the signage and to help get a motion detector light installed.

(Note from Cindi: there are security stickers on the windows)

Issue was raised about use of the church. Whoever was responsible for security for the day, whomever held that

days event, needs to make sure that the church is secure. We are okay with anyone using the church, however, if you are letting someone use the church, then you need to come back and make sure that the door is locked.

Savile will speak to Clemencia about safe church protocol. We need to make sure that the church is secure.

The church/vestry has approved work with Thompson that the work will begin on the updating of the lights.

All work on the outside painting should be begun in June. April meeting adjourned.

July 1st

The vestry would like to make it a point to meet every other month, we will have Cindi check with Jeff and Father Henry and then the rest of the Vestry and be the lead on scheduling.

We did not put in a insurance claim for the break in, it was less than 300 dollars for the window to be fixed. We had our air conditioner serviced in was under \$800

We got a check for \$200 from a funeral on 6/16 (Butsch family) and then Judy Popp Anderson gave for church use a \$100 for Clemencia. We will have Cindi draft a note of thanks to both. \$27,137.58 is in our bank account.

Water was left on at the front of the church and created quite a pool this past weekend. Savile will call Clemencia to let her know and will call Christensen to have them come Tuesday night, and send Cindi an email about what is happening. Jeff moved to accept the treasurers report and Peggy seconded.

8th of July and the 15th of July, Ascension will be doing service at St Johns. On the 8th we will stick with having a service here with Chris; on the 15th we will join the service at 9:00 or 10:30, so we will not have Morning Prayer here.

We will ask Gail to have someone come in and gives us an estimate of how much it would be to replace the sound system.

We will do San Jose Obrero with Austin, we will provide the bacon and tortillas, a pastry and then the water.

Father Henry is working with the Faribault Cathedral, as they do not have a priest. They are doing a priest in partnership. Father Henry has been helping them. They rotate, in helping out. Father Henry has done a funeral, and when Bishop came for confirmation. Father Henry has a limited role, and does not receive any compensation. It should not affect us, but it is good for us to know.

Chris has been our supply priest. And will be here for a few dates to the end of the year. The Vestry has requested to approve all dates for supply priests before the request is made to the other priest.

Jonathan Smith will be coming down from Faribault. He is in the seminary at Yale/Harvard. He will be here until mid August. He will next be down the 29th of July. We will see how he can help with our search for Beloved Community. Meeting adjourned. Next meeting will be in August as we have to have one before Convention.
